QUESTIONS & ANSWERS ABOUT THE LIFESTYLE STEWARDSHIP CAMPAIGN

Q. *What is sacrificial giving?*

A. Sacrificial giving requires a measure of stewardship above and beyond regular, proportional giving. It is regular giving and then some, under the leadership of the Holy Spirit. It requires a reassessment of your lifestyle, a rearrangement of your priorities, and reallocation of your resources.

Q. *Won't our regular giving be reduced because of the campaign?*

A. Experience has shown and our consultant confirms that stewardship improves during such an effort. Because of our obedience, God moves on the hearts of people and giving becomes more **GOD**-focused.

Q. *What kind of commitment will I be asked to make?*

A. You are asked to prayerfully allow GOD to direct your giving to reflect what HE can do through you for the next three years.

Q. *When will we make our commitments?*

A. Commitments will be received during our **Major Event / Commitment Celebration** that will be held on **Sunday, February 24, 2019.**

Q. *How will I pay my commitment?*

A. A special envelope will be provided. You may allocate your giving weekly, monthly, quarterly, annually, or in a lump sum amount.

Q. *Can assets other than cash be committed to the campaign?*

A. Yes, many times major gifts in the form of investment securities, real estate, or other assets are committed. In fact, there is favorable treatment under tax laws for such pledges.

Q. *How can I help with this campaign?*

A. Pray for the success of the campaign. Be positive and encourage others along the way. Be obedient and trust GOD to do great things in the life of our church. *"If they obey and serve HIM, they will spend the rest of their days in prosperity and their years in contentment."* Job 36:11

Q. *Will my commitment be made public?*

A. No! As with all church receipts, commitments are confidential. There may be a few pre-selected leaders and lay members the Pastor and the Executive Committee may ask to share their testimony/commitment publicly, but all other commitments are private and personal.

Q. *When do commitments begin?*

A. We are asking everyone to give something on their three-year commitment on our **No Limits First Fruits Sunday, March 3, 2019.**
